

Submitting Artwork for the 2014 Congressional Art Competition

All submissions due by April 11th

1. Create an original piece of art that meets all of the qualifications listed on the enclosed [2014 Competition Guidelines](#). (NOTE: The piece of art must be 2-dimensional and no larger than 28x28x4 when framed)
2. Complete the enclosed [2014 Student Information/Release Form](#)
3. Send completed Student Information/Release Form to:

4. Email a high-resolution, up-close photo that clearly shows the artwork to: IA02artcontest@mail.house.gov. See sample below:



5. Ensure that full name, name of school, title of piece and phone number (for contact purposes), along with the attached picture of artwork, are included in the email (NOTE: The picture, along with its title, student's name and name of the school will be listed on <http://loeb sack.house.gov> for online voting purposes)
6. BOTH the mailed Information/Release Form AND the email with attached picture of artwork must be received by **April 11th at 11:59pm** for the registration to be complete and valid
7. Online voting will begin in mid-to late- April. Exact date will be announced by April 14th
8. The piece chosen by the public will hang in the tunnel leading to the U.S. Capitol for one year
