

Submitting Artwork for the 2015 Congressional Art Competition

DEADLINE EXTENDED: All submissions now due April 10th

1. Create an original piece of art that meets all of the qualifications listed on the enclosed [2015 Competition Guidelines](#).

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- i. The piece of art must be 2-dimensional and no larger than 28x28x4 when framed
 - ii. There is a limit of ONE submission per student. There is NO limit on the number of submissions from each school

 4. Email a high-resolution (1-2MB), up-close jpeg attachment that clearly shows the artwork to: IA02artcontest@mail.house.gov. See sample below:



5. Ensure student's full name, name of school, title of piece and phone number (for contact purposes), along with the attached picture of artwork, are included in the email (NOTE: The picture, along with its title, student's name and name of the school will be listed on <http://loeb sack.house.gov> for online voting purposes)
6. BOTH the mailed Information/Release Form AND the email with attached picture of artwork must be received by **April 10th at 11:59pm** for the registration to be complete and valid
7. Online voting will begin in mid-April. The specific date will be announced.
8. The piece chosen by the public will hang in the tunnel leading to the U.S. Capitol for one year

IMPORTANT DATES

February 23- Contest opens

April 10- Contest closes. Both mailed Information/Release Form and email with attached picture due

Mid-April- Online voting begins (Specific date will be announced)

April 22- Online voting closes

April 24- Winner announced
